




## Basic Outline


- ▶ Presentation Content

# Presentation Delivery

Each team will be assessed for content and delivery. It is important that groups rehearse to ensure high quality.

- ▶ **Target Audience**

- ▶ This presentation is intended to be for members of the constituent population, especially those who are most at risk. Language should be tailored for not only comprehension, but also influence intention to change behavior and environment.

- ▶ **Time of Presentation**

- ▶ Each group will 20 minutes to present. This includes oral delivery, any audio-visual components, and transition time between team members. In fairness to all students, the time limit will be strictly adhered to.

- ▶ **Professional Attire**

- ▶ Team members who are presenting should be dressed to reflect credibility and confidence to members of the public. At a very minimum, this should include business attire.

# Presentation Delivery

Each team will be assessed for content and delivery. It is important that groups rehearse to ensure high quality.

- ▶ **Automatic (Timed) Transition of Slideshow**
  - ▶ Presentations must be set to automatic advancement of slides involving use of timing (duration) functions. Changing slides manually is not allowed. Team members may hold up signs or other messaging to inform presenter of time points. **Powerpoint or Prezi slides are meant to complement oral presentation; content should not read verbatim (word-for-word) off slides.**
- ▶ **Assessment of Presentation**
  - ▶ As with all other HSC 315 assignments, every student on team will receive the same grade for ASSIGNMENT #3. All students, irrespective of whether they are presenting, are accountable for any questions posed by the Tutorial Instructor or audience members. Every student must meaningfully participate in the preparation and delivery of the presentation, including follow up.
